
GUIDE TO CURRICULUM RESOURCES

Curriculum Materials: Use the **Library Catalog** to search for materials located in the library's Curriculum Collection. The Curriculum Collection is located on the lower level of the library.

1. From the library homepage (<http://lib.sdstate.edu>), choose **Library Catalog**. SD State University should appear at the top of the page. If not, use the Change Library pull-down menu to select SD State University.
2. Enter **keyword** in search box (i.e. mathematics).
3. Click the **Limit Search** button.
4. Under **Optional Limits** use the **Collection** pull-down menu to select **Curriculum Collection**.
5. Click **Search** or press **Enter**.

Books: Use the **Library Catalog** to locate books on the teaching of various subjects. Example: mathematics AND study and teaching AND secondary. These items are typically located on the upper level of the library.

Articles: From the library homepage (<http://lib.sdstate.edu>), choose **Research by Topic**. Select **Education**. This guide provides a list of relevant databases that can be searched to identify articles on education. Use the **Magazines and Journals List** from the library's homepage to determine if SDSU owns or provides electronic access to periodical titles.

Additional Materials: The Guide to Education Research provides links to numerous online curriculum websites and other tools for teachers in the **Web Links** and **Curriculum** sections.
